Northeast Area Royal Rangers Campsite Inspection Checklist

Shelter / Tents

- ___ 1) Setup
 - ___ Uniformly spaced in a line, semi-circle, or circle
 - ___ Not sagging or leaning, poles straight, properly staked down
- ___ 2) Inside
 - ___ All gear put away
 - ___ Sleeping bags and gear stored neatly and consistently
 - ___ No food or drinks in the tents
 - ___ No trash, dirty clothes, etc. lying around
- ___ 3) Outside
 - ___ No clothing, towels, etc. hung on the tents.
 - ___ Clothesline is out of harm's way
 - ___ Doors uniformly open or closed
 - ___ Fire buckets
 - *Every 10 x 10 or larger tent needs one
 - *Smaller tents need 1 bucket for every 2 tents
 - *Don't use wash buckets or cooking pots as fire buckets

Kitchen / Dining Area

- ___ 1) Clean
 - ___ All tables clean
 - ___ Pots, pans, dishes, utensils etc. put away clean and dry
 - ___ Food stored in suitable containers
 - ___ No scraps or trash in the area
- ___ 2) Stoves and Fuel
 - ___ All fuel containers stored away from fire or stove
 - ___ Fuel shut off on stoves when not in use
 - ___ Fire extinguisher near stoves
- ___ 3) Fires:
 - ___ Fire fighting equipment on hand (water or sand buckets, shovels)
 - ___ Firewood stacked away from the fire pit
 - ___ Firewood stacked neatly and covered with tarp
 - ___ Cut and chop area roped off and ropes flagged
 - ___ Tools sheathed and stored when not in use
- ___ 4) Grease Pit
 - ___ Area roped off
 - ___ Covered with sticks and grass or suitable cover

- ____ 5) Garbage
 - ____ Bags must be tied shut and off the ground, cans must have a lid that fits tightly
- ____ 6) Bulletin Board
 - ____ Duty Roster
 - ____ Menu
 - ____ Camp Schedule
- ____ 7) First Aid Kit
 - ____ Properly labeled and in plain view

Perimeter / Entranceway

- ____ 1) Perimeter
 - ____ Entire camp roped or fenced off
- ____ 2) Entranceway
 - ____ Outpost sign or banner
 - ____ Lashing done correctly
 - ____ Free of trip hazards and holes

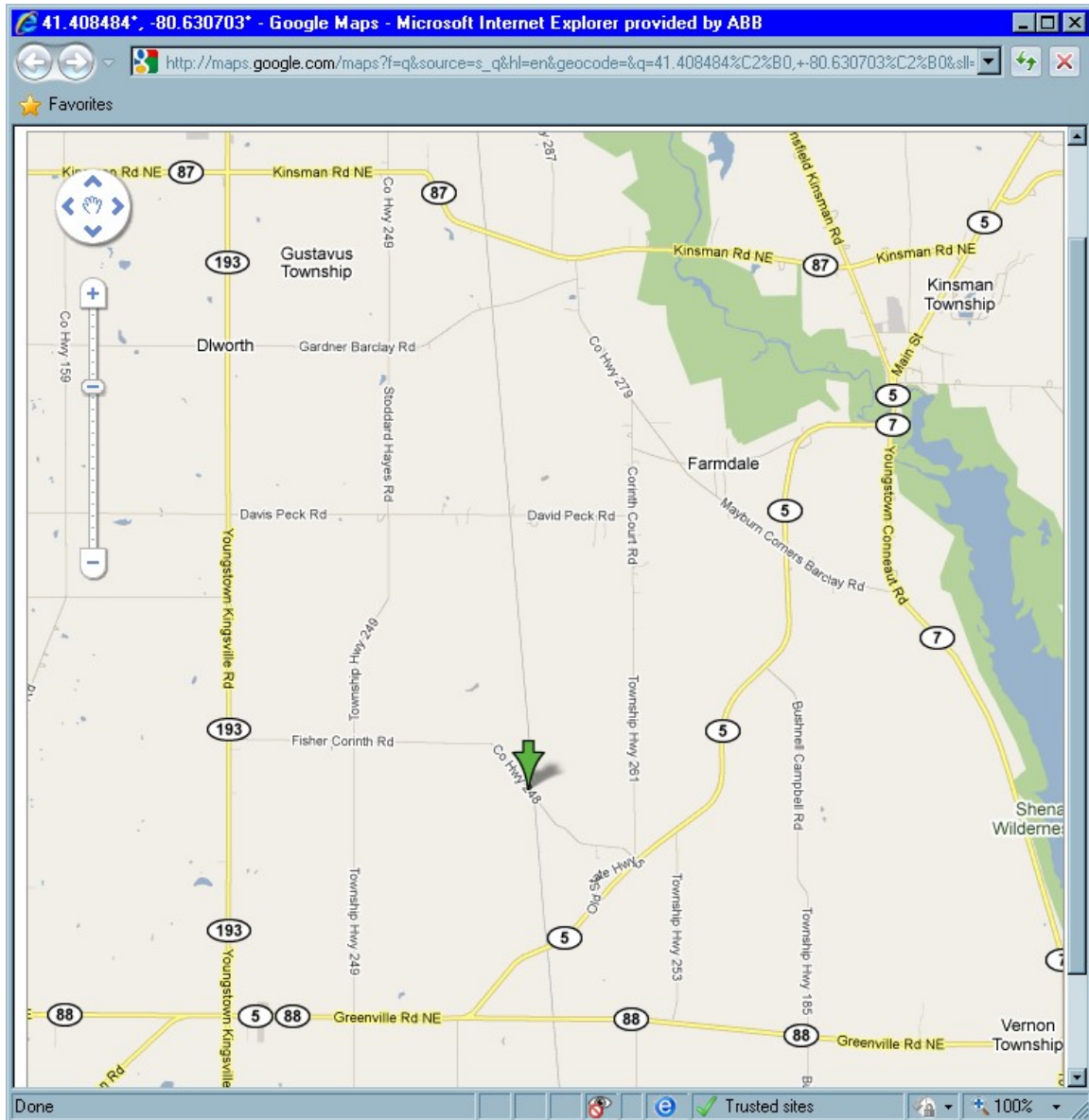

Airsoft rules:

1. Dress the same as if playing paintball (long sleeves and long pants)
2. No pellets
3. No CO2 guns
4. Spring or battery guns only
5. All guns to be checked in and left at registration (to keep the camp safe from accidental firing and to chronograph the guns)
6. Lithium batteries only, since Nicad will lose their charge overnight
7. No lending personal guns to other players in case of accidental breakage
8. Bring face/eye personal protection to be approved by commanders
9. Airsoft guns and face/eye personal protection will be available for those who would like to play
